

Adult Student Scholarships

Fall 2005 and Spring 2006

1. Barksdale Warrior Paper Company – Robert M. Barksdale Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate students, with priority given to Barksdale-Warrior Paper Company employees and their dependents who plan to enroll in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Secondary consideration will be given to applicants from the West Alabama area who are at least 25 years old, who demonstrate satisfactory academic progress, and who are enrolled in programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

2. James C. Caldwell Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student. Priority will be given to applicants from Winston and Marion counties; secondary consideration will be given to deserving applicants who are enrolled in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Demonstration of financial need (*not necessarily as defined by Federal guidelines*) may also be a consideration for the award. The amount is variable.

3. Thomas S. Graves Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student, currently enrolled or accepted for admission, who has demonstrated academic excellence. The student must be at least 25 years old, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and be an Alabama resident. Additionally, the student must major in a science-based curriculum and be enrolled in, at least, one College of Continuing Studies' course during the semester in which the award is received. Secondary consideration is given to applicants from any other academic division. Priority will be given to Etowah and Cherokee county residents. This scholarship is merit based; financial need is not required. The amount is variable.

4. James A. Hood Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student, who is currently enrolled or has been accepted for admission. The applicant must be at least 25 years old, a resident of Alabama, and a graduate of the state's public school system. The applicant must be pursuing a degree as a teacher or school administrator and be planning to enroll in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

5. Elizabeth B. and Ronald C. Howard Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate student who is enrolled in the External Degree (EXD) program. Preference will be given to students who have completed at least 12 semester hours of graded work under the auspices of the EXD program and who have a GPA of 2.0 or better. Demonstration of financial need

(*not necessarily as defined by Federal guidelines*) may also be a consideration for an award. The amount is variable.

6. Jerold Kennedy Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate students who are at least 25 years old and who are enrolled in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Preference will be given to students pursuing degrees in disciplines served by the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

7. Robert Ross MacDonald Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate student with at least a 2.5 GPA. Priority consideration will be given to Alabama residents, first from families involved directly in the trucking industry, and then from families in businesses that indirectly support the trucking industry. Secondary consideration shall be given to applicants who enroll in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies, with priority given to deserving students who demonstrate financial need (*not necessarily as defined by Federal guidelines*). The amount is variable.

8. Colonel Floyd H. and Grace L. Mann Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student, who is enrolled or has been accepted for admission. Priority will be given to students who are children of law enforcement officials and/or who intend to pursue careers in law enforcement and who demonstrate financial need (*not necessarily as defined by Federal guidelines*). The amount is variable.

9. The Eber Mann Memorial Endowed Scholarship. Students from Winston or surrounding counties are given priority for this scholarship. It is awarded to a full-time University of Alabama undergraduate student whose high school academic records, college entrance exams, and character indicate a reasonable probability of success. Secondary consideration will be given to deserving applicants who plan to enroll in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies and who demonstrate financial need (*not necessarily as defined by Federal guidelines*). The amount is variable.

10. Clarice L. Parker Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This award is given to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student, currently enrolled or accepted for admission. An applicant must be at least 25 years old, an Alabama resident, and have a 2.5 GPA or above for the previous semester. The student must be enrolled in at least one College of Continuing Studies' course during the semester in which the award is received and must demonstrate financial need. Primary preference will be given to students from Tuscaloosa County. Applicants also must have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (*FAFSA*) form. The amount is variable.

11. Harrison and Lois Parrish Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time undergraduate University of Alabama student who intends to

major in nursing and who is enrolled in at least one credit course given via distance education through the College of Continuing Studies. Priority will be given to students who are Alabama residents and who are taking courses through Quality University Extended Site Telecourses (QUEST), and who demonstrate financial need. The amount is variable.

12. Douglas W. Patterson Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student, currently enrolled or accepted for admission. An applicant must be at least 25 years old and enrolled in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Preference is given to students in disciplines served by the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

13. William Henry Rhea, Jr. Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is given to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student who is an Alabama resident at least 25 years old, who demonstrates academic excellence (minimum 3.0 GPA) and establishes financial need. Preference will be given to students who major in engineering or business and take courses facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

14. John C. Snider Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate students who are at least 25 years old and who are enrolled in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. The recipient must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress. The amount is variable.

15. Ruth P. Snider Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate students who are at least 25 years old and are enrolled in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Students with a major or minor in music, music education, or a related field will be given preference. The recipient must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress. The amount is variable.

16. Hershel Trimm Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is given to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student who is currently enrolled or has been accepted for admission. An applicant must be at least 25 years old, an Alabama resident, and have a 2.5 GPA or above for the previous semester. The applicant must be enrolled in, at least, one College of Continuing Studies' course during the semester in which the award is received. Priority will be given to those who desire careers in the home-building industry. The amount is variable.

17. Robert L. Williamson Endowed Memorial Scholarship. This award is given to a University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student who is currently enrolled or accepted for admission and who is over the age of 25. Applicants must major in engineering or business and must be facilitating their education through the College of Continuing Studies and its Division of Distance Education. Priority will be given to undergraduate students who are taking, at least, one course through Quality University Extended Site Telecourses (QUEST), or other distance learning methods. Applicants must demonstrate academic excellence (GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale) and show financial need. The amount is variable.

18. Jerry F. Wilson, Sr. Memorial Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a University of Alabama part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student who is currently enrolled or accepted for admission and who is at least 25 years old. The applicant must be enrolled in an academic program facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies. Preference is given to students pursuing degrees in disciplines served through the Distance Education division of the College of Continuing Studies. The amount is variable.

19. Judith H. Wilson Endowed Scholarship. This award is given to a part-time or full-time University of Alabama undergraduate student who is enrolled or accepted for admission and who is pursuing a degree in nursing. Students from Marion and Winston counties will be given priority consideration. Applicants must be facilitating their education through the College of Continuing Studies Quality University Extended Site Telecourses (QUEST) program or other distance learning methods. The amount is variable.

20. Warrior Roofing – Thomas G. Shurett Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to a full-time University of Alabama undergraduate or graduate student who is currently enrolled or accepted for admission and who is an Alabama resident. Priority will be given to students who intend to enroll in academic programs facilitated through the College of Continuing Studies during the term in which the award is received. Preference will be given to Warrior Roofing Company Inc., employees (or their dependents) and students from West Alabama. The amount is variable.
